(129) That certain tract of land in the northwest quarter ($NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$) of southeast quarter ($SE_{\frac{1}{4}}$) of section twenty (20), township two (2) north, range ten (10) east, Willamette Meridian, in said Hood River County, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the northwest quarter ($NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$) of southeast quarter ($SE_{\frac{1}{4}}$) of said section twenty (20); thence west along said south line of the northwest quarter ($NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$) of southeast quarter ($SE_{\frac{1}{4}}$) to the top of bluff on the northerly side of the stream of Hood River; thence northeasterly along said bluff line to an intersection with the east line of said northwest quarter ($NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$) of southeast quarter ($SE_{\frac{1}{4}}$); thence south to the place of beginning, including riparian and other rights to the waters of said stream.

(130) All that part of the northeast quarter (NE¹/₄) of southeast quarter (SE¹/₄) of section twenty (20), township two (2) north, range ten (10 east, Willamette Meridian, in said Hood River County, bounded and described as follows; All that part of the northeast quarter (NE¹/₄) of southeast quarter (SE¹/₄) of said section twenty (20), lying between a line 100 feet southeasterly of and parallel to the high water mark on the southeasterly bank of the stream of Hood River and the line marking the high water on the northwesterly bank of said stream, including riperian and other rights to the waters of said stream.

(131) All that part of the northwest quarter (NW1) of section thirty-one (31), township two (2) north, range ten (10) east, Willamette Meridian, in said Hood River County, lying northerly and westerly of a line 100 feet easterly of and parallel to the high water mark on the southerly and easterly bank of the stream of Hood River.

(132) That certain tract of land in the south half (S_{2}^{1}) of southwest quarter (S_{4}^{1}) section twenty (20), township two (2) north, range ten (10) east, Willamette Meridian, in said Hood River County, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the south line of said section twenty (20), 990 feet east of the southwest corner thereof, said point being 115 feet, more or less, west of the high water mark on the westerly bank of the stream of Hood River; thence north 35° east168.5 feet; thence north 38°30' east 394.5 feet; thence north 41° east 418 feet; thence north 49°30' east 163.5 feet; thence north 65° east 250 feet; thence north 71°30' east 259 feet; thence north 52° east 300 feet; thence north 62° east 200 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of said south half (S_2^1) of southwest quarter (S_4^1) ; thence south to the southeast corner thereof; thence west to the place of beginning, together with all riparian rights appurtenant to said south half (S_2^1) of southwest quarter (S_4^1) of section twenty (20); also a right-of-way 100 feet in width along the stream of Hood River across the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section twenty (20); also one acre of land to be selected hereafter out of said southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of southeast quarter $(SE_{\frac{1}{2}})$ of section twenty (20).

(133) That certain tract of land in the north half (N½) of northwest quarter (NW½) of Section twenty-nine (29), township two (2) north, range ten (10) east, Willamette Meridian, in said Hood River County, described as follows:

All that part of the north half (N½) of northwest quarter (NW¼) of section twenty-nine (29) township two (2) north, range ten (10) east Willamette Meridian, lying along the stream of Hood River and between the bluffs on either side of said river that would be flooded at the level of the dam 40 feet high if such a dam were erected across the stream of Hood River upon the point of rocks 100 feet north of north line of said section twenty-nine (29) together with a right-of-way 30 feet inwidthhandojoining and around the tract of land described; also a right-of-way across section twenty-nine (29), running down the stream of Hood River; also a right-of-way 20 feet in width along the north and south center line of
