Fich, sons of Friedrich Fich, also known as Fred Fich, deceased, the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (10.00) and other valuable consideration lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hend paid by Frank Fich, the part y of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said part y of the second part a certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 22nd day of May A.D. 1924, made and executed by Frank Fink and Mary Fink, husband and wife, Mortgagers to Fred Fich, Mortgagee and recorded on the 23rd day of May A.D. 1924, in Book \*P\* of Mortgages, at page 615 in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamenia, State of Washington:

And said parties of the first part do by these presents grant, bargain, sell assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part a certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 23rd day of October A.D. 1924, made and executed by Frank Fink and Mary Fink, his wife, Mortgagors, to Friedrich Fich, Mortgagee, and recorded on the 24th day of October A.D. 1924, in Book "R" of Mortgages, at page 85 in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamania, State of Washington.

Together with the notes thereindescribed, and the money due and to become due thereon, with the interest.

And the said parties of the first part do hereby make, constitute and appoint the said part y of the second part their true and lawful attorney, irrevocable, in their name or otherwise, but at the proper costs and charges of the said part y of the second part, to have, use and take all lawful ways and means for the recovery of the said money and interest, and in case of payment to discharge the same as fully as the said parties of the first part might or could do if these presents were not made.

The grantors and grantee herein are the heirs and all of the heirs at law of said Friedrich Fich, also known as Fred Fich, who died intestate in September, 1930. This assignment is intended to take the place of an assignment made by said Friedrich Fich, also known as Fred Fich, during his lifetime but which said assignment cannot now be found.
