FARM MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE, Made this 2nd day of July, 1934, by Georgia M. Nichols, a widow, of Carson in the County of Skemania, State of Washington, mortgagors, to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, at his office and place of business in the City of Spokane, State of Washington, mortgagee,

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of a loan to the mortgagors, evidenced as hereinafter described, the mortgagors hereby mortgage to the mortgagee the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty-one, Township Three North, Range Eight, East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence North 1020 feet, thence East 690 feet, thence South 1020 feet, and thence West 690 feet to place of beginning,

or hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the above abscribed premises, now and all plumbing, lighting, heating, cooking, cooling, ventilating, elevating, watering and irrigating apparatus and fixtures, now or hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the above described premises; and together with all water and water rights of every kind and description and however evidenced or manufested, which now or hereafter may be appurtenant to said premises of any part thereof, or any part thereof or used inv connection therewith; and together with all of the rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged property.

This mortgage is given as security for the performance of the covenants hereinafter contained and for payment to the mortgagee at his (the Commissioner's) office in
the City of Spokane, State of Washington, of the debt evidenced by one promisory note
executed by the mortgagors to the order of the mortgagee of even date herewith, for the
principal sum of \$900.00 together with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent
per annum from the date hereof until paid, payable semi-annually on the whole of said
principal sum from time to time remaining unpaid; the principal sum being due in semiannual installments of \$45.00 each, beginning on January 1st, 1938, the last of such
installments being due on July 1st, 1947; the mortgagors having the privilege of paying
at any time one or more installments of principal or the entire unpaid balance of said
principal sum; said note providing for the payment of a reasonable attorney's fee in
addition to other costs of suit thereon, and further providing that principal payments
in addition to those therein contracted to be made shall operate to discharge the debt
