FOR CAUSE OF ACTION AGAINST THE DEFENDANT, PLAINTIFF ALLEGES:

1.

THAT ON NOVEMBER 30, 1906, THE PLAINTIFF AND DEFENDANT HEREIN WERE  
MARRIED AT VANCOUVER, B.C. AND EVER SINCE SAID DATE HAVE BEEN AND NOW ARE HUSBAND  
AND WIFE.

2.

THAT FOR MORE THAN ONE YEAR LAST PAST, THE PLAINTIFF HEREIN HAS BEEN A  
RESIDENT OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, AND IS NOW RESIDING WITHIN LEWIS COUNTY.

3.

THAT PLAINTIFF AND DEFENDANT OWN NO COMMUNITY PROPERTY, REAL OR PERSONAL;  
THAT PRIOR TO PLAINTIFFS MARRIAGE TO DEFENDANT, HE WAS AND STILL IS THE <sup>SOLE</sup> OWNER OF  
THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY, TO-WIT:

NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER, AND A PART OF THE NORTHEAST  
QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTH-  
EAST QUARTER; THENCE RUNNING EAST  $481\frac{1}{2}$  FEET TO THE COUNTY ROAD; THENCE NORTH ALONG  
SAID COUNTY ROAD 537 FEET; THENCE WEST  $481\frac{1}{2}$  FEET; THENCE SOUTH 527 FEET TO THE  
PLACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING IN ALL 46 ACRES, MORE OR LESS AND ALL BEING IN  
SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 13 NORTH RANGE 4 WEST OF W.M. IN LEWIS COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

THAT DURING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 1919, THE DEFENDANT WITHOUT CAUSE,  
AND FOR REASONS UNKNOWN TO THE PLAINTIFF HEREIN, LEFT AND ABANDONED PLAINTIFF;  
THAT PLAINTIFF TRIED TO EFFECT A RECONCILIATION WITH THE DEFENDANT, BUT THAT DEFEN-  
DANT NEVER RETURNED; THAT DEFENDANT WAS RELIABLY INFORMED AND BELIEVED, AND THERE-
