This mortgage, made this 1st day of October, 1934, by Anna P. Reynolds and Charles H. Reynolds, wife and husband, of Skamania in the County of Skamania, State of Washington mortgagors, to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, at his office and place of business in the City of Spokane, State of Washington, mortgagee,

Witnesseth: That in consideration of a loan to the mortgagors, evidenced as here-inafter described, the mortgagors hereby MORTGAGE TO the mortgagee the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-three, township two North, Range Six, East of the Willamette Meridian.

Together with all interest of the mortgagors in a certain spring located approximately 60 feet south and 40 feet west of the northeast corner of section five, township one north, range six, east of the Willamette Meridian, and the right to take water therefrom by pipe line or other means, and all easements connected therewith,

together with the tenements, hereditaments, rights, privileges and appurtenances, now on hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the above described premises; and all plumbing, lighting, heating, cooking, cooling, ventilating, elevating, watering and irrigating apparatus and fixtures, now or hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the above described premises; and together with all waters and water rights of every kind and description and however evidenced or manifested, which now or hereafter may be appurtenant to said premises or any part thereof, or incident to the ownership thereof, any part thereof, or used in connection the rewith; and together with all of the rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged property.

This mortgage is given as security for the performance of the covenants hereinafter contained and for payment to the mortgagee at his (the Commissioner's) office in the City of Spokane, State of Washington, of the debt evidenced by one promissory note executed by the mortgagors to the order of the mortgagee of even date herewith, for the principal sum of \$400.00 together with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent per annum from the date hereof until paid, payable semi-annually on the whole of said principal sum from time to time remaining unpaid; the principal sum being due in semi-annual installments of \$20.00 each, beginning on April 1st, 1938, the last of such installments being due on October 1st, 1947; the mortgagors having the privilege of paying at any time one or more installments of principal or the entire unpaid balance of said principal sum; said note providing for the payment of a reasonable attorney's fee in addition to other costs of suit thereon, and further providing that principal payments in addition to those therein contracted to be made shall operate to discharge the debt evidenced thereby at an earlier date and shall not reduce the amount or defer the due date of any installment of principal therein provided.

Each of the mortgagors covenants that they are lawfully seized of said premises in fee simple, have good right and lawful authority to convey and mortgage said premises in the manner and form as aforesaid, and that said premises are free from encumbrances, except as herein stated, and each of the mortgagors shall and will WARRANT and DEFEND the same forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, and this covenant shall not be extinguished by any foreclosure hereof, but shall run with the land.

And each of the mortgagors further covenants and agrees:

To pay all debts and moneys secured hereby, when from any cause the same shall become
