(q) Beginning at the electric substation of the company in the City of Dufur in Wasco, County; thence in an easterly direction through Erskine, Moro and DeMoss Springs, in Sherman County, Olex, in Gilliam County, and Ione and Lexington, in Morrow County, to the electric substation of the Company in the City of Heppner, in Morrow County; all in the State of Oregon;

(r) Beginning at the electric substation of the Company in the City of Arlington in Gilliam County; thence in a southerly direction through Olex, Condon and Mayville in said Gilliam County, to the electric substation of the Company in the City of Fossil, in Wheeler County; all in the State of Oregon;

(s) Beginning at the power house of the Company situated on White River in Section Seven (7), Township Four (4) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, Willamette Meridian; thence in a northerly direction to the electric substation of the Company in Dalles City; all in Wasco County, Oregon;

(t) Beginning at the power house of the Company situated on the stream of Hood River in Section Thirty-six (36), Township Three (3) North, Range Ten (10) East, Willamette Meridian, in Hood River County, Oregon; thence in an easterly direction to the electric substation of the Company in Dalles City, in Wasco County, Oregon;

(u) Beginning at the electric substation of the Company in Dalles City, in Wasco County, Oregon; thence in a northeasterly and northerly direction through Wishram and Centerville, in Klickitat County, Washington, to the electric substation of the Company in the City of Goldendale, in said Klickitat County;

(v) Beginning at the power house of the Company situated on the stream of Hood River, in Section Thirty-six (36), Township Three (3) North, Range Ten (10) East, Willamette Meridian, in Hood River County, Oregon; thence northerly across the Columbia River to the Northwestern Electric Company's power house on the White Salmon River, in Section Ten (10), Township Three (3) North, Range Ten (10) East, Willamette Meridian, in Klickitat County, Washington;

(w) Beginning at the Northwestern Electric Company's power house situated on the White Salmon River, in Section Ten (10), Township Three (3) North, Range Ten (10) East, Willamette Meridian, in Klickitat County, Washington; thence in a northeasterly direction to the electric substation of the Company situated in Section Six (6), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Nineteen (19) East, Willamette Meridian, in Yakima County, Washington;

(x) Beginning at the power house of the Company situated on the stream of Hood River, in Section Thirty-six (36), Township Three (3) North, Range Ten (10) East, willamette Meridian, in Hood River County Oregon; thence in a southerly direction to the electric substation of the Company near Odell, in said Hood River County;

(y) Beginning at the power house of the Company situated on Youngs Bay, in Clatsop County, Oregon; thence in a westerly and southerly direction through Warrenton, Gearhart and Seaside to the electric substation of the Company at Cannon Beach, all in said Clatsop County;
