Miller and Ruth Miller, his wife, the sum of \$71.95, United States Lawful Money, with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from the date hereof until paid; together with said plaintiff's costs and disbursements incurred in said action, amounting to the sum of \$6.40.
