The following described real property situate in Clatsop County, Oregon, to-wit:

Tract No. O.K. 1: Beginning at a point in the most Northerly boundary line of Taylor Avenue, in Taylor's Astoria, in Clatsop County, Oregon, at the most southwesterly corner of a tract conveyed by Ione E. White, et al to A. V. Allen and C. B. Allen by deed dated December 29, 1903, which deed is recorded in Book No. 53 of Records of Deeds for Clatsop County, Oregon, at Page 20 thereof; and running thence Northerly along the most Westerly boundary of said tract so conveyed to said A. V. Allen and C. B.
