THIS INDENTURE, MADE THIS 7TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1923 BETWEEN JOHN C. WACHTER AS TREASURER OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, AND GEORGE E. O'BRYON PARTY OF THE SECOND PART;

WITNESSETH, THAT WHEREAS, AT PUBLIC SALE OF REAL ESTATE HELD ON THE 30TH DAY OF JULY A.D. 1923, PURSUANT TO AN ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA STATE OF WASHINGTON, DULY MADE AND ENTERED, AND AFTER HAVING FIRST GIVEN DUE NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE AND TERMS OF SAID SALE; AND,

O'BRYON THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL ESTATE, AND WHICH SAID REAL ESTATE IS THE PROPERTY OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, AND WHICH IS PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

THE NORTH HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION NINE TOWNSHIP ONE NORTH OF RANGE FIVE EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN; ALSO THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER AND THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION THIRTY-THREE, AND THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION THIRTY-FOUR ALL IN TOWNSHIP THREE NORTH OF RANGE FIVE EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN; ALSO THE NORTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER AND THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION THIRTEEN TOWNSHIP THREE NORTH OF RANGE SIX EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN; ALSO THE WEST HALF AND THE SOUTH-
