THIS CONVEYANCE is intended as a MORTGAGE to secure the payment of Ten Hundred Fifty and no/100 DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States, together with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum from date until paid, according to the terms and conditions of two certain promissory note_, bearing date 7-29-1937 and 8-31-1937 in amts. \$600.00 and \$450.00 made by N. R. Murray and Rosemary Murray, the \$600.00 note payable \$50.00 on 9-1-1937 and equal amt. on 1st of each month thereafter \$450.00 note payable \$35.00 on 10-10-1937 and equal amount on 10th of each month thereafter after date to the order of Citizens State Bank of Cames, Wash. and these presents shall be void if such payment be made according to the terms and conditions thereof, But in case default be made in the payment of the principal or interest of said promissory note, or any part thereof, when the same shall become due and payable, according to the terms and conditions thereof, then the said party of the second part, its heirs, executors, administrators or assigns may immediately thereater, in the manner provided by law, foreclose this mortgage for the whole amount due upon said principal and interest, with all the other sums hereby secured.

In any suit or other proceedings which may be had for the recovery of the amount due, on either said note or this mortgage, said party of the second part, its heirs, executors, administrators or assigns shall have the right to have included in the judgment which may be recovered, the sum of \$ a reasonable sum as attorney's fees, to be taxed as part of the costs in such suit, as will as all payments which said party of the second part, its heirs, executors, administrators and assigns may be obliged to make for its or their security by insurance or on account of any taxes, charges, incumbrances or assessments whatsoever on the said premises or any part thereof.
