PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE W4122

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Federal Farm Mortgage corporation, a corporation duly established by the Act of Congress known as the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act, approved January 31st, 1934, and A.
