PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE W4122

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Federal Farm Mortgage corporation, a corpora-
tion duly established by the Act of Congress known as the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation
Act, approved January 31st, 1934, and A. S. Goss as Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant
to Part 3 of the Act of Congress known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, by their
attorney-in-fact, The Federal Land Bank of Spokane, a corporation, hereby, for a valuable
consideration, release from the lien of that certain mortgage executed by Monica Brodala,
a widow To the Land Bank Commissioner, dated August 1st, 1934, and recorded in Book T of
Mortgages on page 341 in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, State of
Washington, that part of the property covered by said mortgage described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land containing 0.32 acres, more or less, in the Northeast quarter of
the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 1 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette
Meridian, included within the right of way of S.S.H. No. 8-B, as now located and of
record in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia, Washington, described
as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 4
lying Southerly of the following described Northerly right of way line of said S.S.H.
No. 8-B: Commence at the corner common to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 1 North,
Range 5, East of the Willamette Meridian, thence North on the section line 1320 feet,
more or less, to the Southeast corner of the northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quar-
ter of said Section 4, thence continuing North on said Section line 30 feet, more or
less, to the Northerly right of way line of said S. S. H. No. 8-B, and the true point
of beginning of the line being herein described;

Thence South 85° 37' West 553 feet, more or less, thence North 4° 23' West 20 feet,
thence South 85° 37' West 60.6 feet, thence on the arc of a curve to the left whose
radius is 1005 feet, a distance 146.7 feet, thence turning an angle of 90° to the
right from a line tangent to the arc of said curve and running North 12° 45' West 40
feet, thence turning an angle of 90° to the left to a line tangent to the arc of a
curve, thence on the arc of a curve, whose radius is 1045 feet, a distance of 109.4
feet, thence turning an angle of 90° to the left from a line tangent to the arc of
a curve and running South 18°45' East 48 feet, more or less, to the South line of the
Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 4.
