1. Electric transmission and distribution systems.

2. (a) Franchise granted by Ordinance No. 29, November 10, 1908, by the Town of Stevenson, to the Company's predecessor, Sam Samson and A. L. Orsen.

(b) Franchise granted January 5, 1909, by the Board of County Commissioners of Skamania County to the Company's predecessor Skamania Light and Power Company.

(c) Franchise granted September 8, 1925, by the Board of County Commissioners of Skamania County to the Company's predecessor, Skamania Light and Power Company.

(d) Franchise No. 373 granted June 26, 1928, by State Highway Committee of the State of Washington to the Company's predecessor, Peoples West Coast Hydro-Electric Corporation.

IN WAHKIAKUM COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

1. A portion of Lot Nine (9) Block "J", of the Town of Cathlamet, Wahkiakum County, Washington, according to the plat thereof on record in the office of the Auditor of said County and State, said portion being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeasterly corner of said Block "J", thence running southwesterly along the northerly boundary line of said Block "J" one hundred and thirty (130) feet to a point; thence turning a right angle to the left and running on a line to a point where such line intersects the dividing line between lots eight (8) and nine (9) of said Block "J"; thence running easterly on a line parallel with said northerly boundary line of said Block "J" to a point in the easterly boundary line of said Block "J"; thence running northerly along said easterly boundary line of said Block "J" to the place of beginning.

2. A Diesel electric generating plant at Cathlamet and electric transmission and distribution systems.

3. (a) Franchise granted by Ordinance No. 116, January 3, 1916, by the Town of Cathlamet to the Company's predecessor, James G. West.

(b) Franchise granted November 1, 1926, by the Board of County Commissioners of Wahkiakum County to the Company's predecessor, Peoples West Coast Hydro-Electric Corporation.

(c) Franchise No. 381 granted July 31, 1928 by State Highway Committee of the State of Washington to the Company's predecessor, Peoples West Coast Hydro-Electric Corporation.

(d) Franchise No. 485 granted April 1, 1930 by the Director of Highways of the State of Washington to the Company's predecessor, Peoples West Coast Hydro-Electric Corporation.

(e) Franchise No. 537 granted August 26, 1930 by the Director of Highways of the State of Washington to the Company's predecessor, Peoples West Coast Hydro-Electric Corporation.
