THIS INDENTURE, Made this 30th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight BETWEEN Jacob Aalvik and Ellen Aalvik, husband and wife, parties of the first part, and William G. Meneice and Fay M. Meneice, husband and wife parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and 00/100 Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Warrant unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: "

The East half of Lot 3 of Block 6 of Johnson's Addition to the Town of Stevenson, according to the official plat thereof, excepting a strip 20 feet wide from the south end thereof heretofore reserved for right of way purposes.

together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

THIS CONVEYANCE is intended as a MORTGAGE to secure the payment of SEVEN HUNDRED and 00/100 DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States, together with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum from date until paid, according to the terms and conditions of one certain promissory note, bearing date August 30, 1938, made by the parties of the first part hereto, payable in monthly installments of \$20.00 each, payable on the 15th day of each month, commencing October 15, 1938, after date to the order of William G.
