

WM. BUTLER ET UX TO STATE OF WASHINGTON

IN THE MATTER OF STATE ROAD NO. 8

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT WM. BUTLER AND SARAH BUTLER, HIS WIFE, OF THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE BENEFITS AND OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATIONS, AND THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS, IN HAND PAID, RECEIPT WHEREOF IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, HAVE GRANTED, BARGAINED, SOLD AND CONVEYED, AND BY THESE PRESENTS DO GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL AND CONVEY UNTO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, TO-WIT:

Recharge

A STRIP OF LAND 50 FEET WIDE, BEING 50 FEET ON NORTH SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF SAID ROAD AS SURVEYED OVER AND ACROSS THAT PARTICULAR FRACTION OF ONE QUARTER SECTION WRITTEN BELOW, SAID "STRIP OF LAND" BEING DEFINITELY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF LAND IN THE NW $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 34, TWP. 2 N. R. 6 E. W.M., HAVING A WIDTH ON THE NORTHWESTERLY SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED CENTERLINE OF STATE ROAD NO. 8 (NORTH BANK HIGHWAY) IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASH., AS NOW LOCATED AND OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE HIGHWAY ENGINEER AT OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, TO-WIT:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 34 AND RUNNING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION ALONG THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF SAID SEC. 34 A DISTANCE OF 903 FEET TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE CENTERLINE OF SAID STATE ROAD NO. 8 (No. BANK HWY) ; THENCE N. 80° 54' E. 52.0 FEET; THENCE ON THE ARC OF A CURVE TO THE LEFT, HAVING A RADIUS OF 1432.5 FEET A DISTANCE OF 410.0 FT; THENCE NO. 64°30' E., 297.7 FEET; THENCE ON THE ARC OF A CURVE TO THE LEFT, HAVING A RADIUS OF 1910.0 FEET A DISTANCE OF 236.1 FEET; THENCE N. 57° 25' E. 351.6 FEET ; THENCE ON THE ARC OF A CURVE TO THE LEFT, HAVING A RADIUS OF 2865.0 FEET A DISTANCE OF 205.0 FEET; THENCE N.53° 19' E., 374.4 FEET; THENCE ON THE ARC OF A CURVE TO THE LEFT, HAVING A RADIUS OF 2865.0 FEET A DISTANCE OF 241.7 FEET; THENCE N. 48° 29' E., 13.1 FEET; THENCE ON THE ARC OF A CURVE TO THE RIGHT, HAVING A RADIUS OF 1910.0 FEET A DISTANCE OF 316.7 FEET; THENCE N. 57° 59' E. 558.3 FEET TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH AND SOUTH ONE QUARTER LINE OF SAID SECTION 34 AND THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

THENCE CONTINUING N. 57° 59' E., 466.0 FEET, HAVING A WIDTH OF 50.0 FEET ON THE NORTHWESTERLY SIDE, TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE PRESENT TRAVELLED COUNTY ROAD KNOWN AS "LYTLE ROAD", LESS THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE PRESENT TRAVELLED ROAD, AND CONTAINING 0.34 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

SAID PARCEL OF LAND BEING IN THE NW $\frac{1}{4}$ / NW $\frac{1}{4}$ / SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 6 E. W.M.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, UNTO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON FOREVER.
