SELL AND CONVEY UNTO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, TO-WIT:

A STRIP OF LAND 100 FEET WIDE, BEING 50 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF SAID ROAD AS SURVEYED OVER AND ACROSS THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$  OF THE SW $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 29, T. 3. N, R 8 E, W. M. (THIS DEED IS GIVEN IN LIEU OF A PREVIOUS DEED AS RECORDED IN VOL. "T" OF DEEDS, PAGE 512, RECORDS OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASH.) EXCEPT FROM STATION 210x70 TO 211 SAID STRIP OF LAND SHALL BE 55 FEET WIDE ON NORTH SIDE OF SAID CENTER LINE.

CALDERWOOD HIS WIFE, OF THE COUNTY OF LEWIS, IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE BENEFITS AND OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATIONS, AND THE SUM OF ONE DOLLARS, IN HAND PAID, THE RECEIPT WHEREOF IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, HAVE GRANTED, BARGAINED, SOLD AND CONVEYED, AND BY THESE PRESENTS DO GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL AND CONVEY UNTO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, TO-WIT:
