THIS INDENTURE, MADE AND ENTERED INTO THIS THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER, A.D.  
1925, BY AND BETWEEN FRANK R. BRYANT, A WIDOWER, OF KELSO, COUNTY OF COWLITZ, STATE OF  
WASHINGTON, HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED AS PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, AND FRANK H. SHEELEY AND  
H. S. KRESS, OF KELSO, IN SAID COUNTY AND STATE, HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED AS PARTIES OF  
THE SECOND PART,

WITNESSETH: THAT THE SAID PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION  
OF THE SUM OF ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR AND OTHER GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION GOLD COIN  
OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, TO HIM IN HAND PAID BY THE SAID PARTIES OF THE SECOND  
PART, THE RECEIPT WHEREOF IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, DOES BY THESE PRESENTS GRANT, BAR-  
GAIN, SELL, REMISE, RELEASE AND FOREVER QUIT-CLAIM UNTO THE SAID PARTIES OF THE SECOND  
PART AND TO THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, A ONE-FOURTH UNDIVIDED INTEREST IN THE FOLLOWING  
DESCRIBED SIX MINING CLAIMS, SITUATED IN MOUNT ST. HELENS MINING DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY  
OF SKAMANIA, STATE OF WASHINGTON, AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

ONE MINING CLAIM NAMED THE GRACIE B AND LOCATED ON THE 20TH DAY OF JULY, 1925;  
ONE CLAIM NAMED DEER FLY, AND BEARING DATE OF 21RD. DAY OF JULY, 1925; ONE MINING CLAIM  
NAMED THE MORNING GLOREY AND BEARING DATE OF 21ST DAY OF JULY, 1925; ONE MINING CLAIM  
NAMED THE PIPPIN, BEARING DATE OF 20TH DAY OF JULY, 1925; ONE MINING CLAIM NAMED HOWARD  
B. AND BEARING DATE OF 20TH DAY OF JULY, 1925; ONE MINING CLAIM NAMED DODGE MINING CLAIM,  
BEARING DATE OF 21ST DAY OF JULY, 1925. AND ALSO, ONE-FOURTH INTEREST IN ALL BUILDING  
AND MINING EQUIPMENT SITUATED ON THE ABOVE DESCRIBED MINING CLAIMS.
