whole amount due upon said principal and interest, with all the other sums hereby secured.

In any suit or other proceeding which may be had for the recovery of the amount due, or either said note or this mortgage, said party of the second part, its successors or assigns shall have the right to have included in the judgment which may be recovered, a reasonable sum as attorney's fees, to be taxed as part of the costs in such suit as well as all payments which said party of the second part, its successors and assigns may be obliged to make for its or their security by insurance or on account of any taxes, charges, incumbrances or assessments whatsoever on the said premises or any part thereof.

The parties of the first part agree to keep the property insured in the sum of \$1500.00 payable to the party of the second part as its interest may appear.
