THIS SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE, made as of the 1st day of November, 1941, by and between WEST COAST TELEPHONE COMPANY, a corporation duly created, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, and having its principal place of business at Everett, Washington (hereinafter sometimes called the "Company"), the party of the first part, the party of the first part, and BANK OF AMERICA NATIONAL TRUST AND SAVINGS ASSOCIATION, a National Banking Association duly organized under an Act known as the "National Bank Act" of the United States of America and having its principal place of business at San Francisco, California (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporate Trustee") and WILLIAM C. KOENIG, of San Francisco, California (hereinafter referred to as the "Individual Trustee") as Trustees under that certain Indenture hereinafter referred to, the parties of the second part;

WHEREAS, the Company executed and delivered an Indenture (hereinafter referred to as the "Indenture"), dated as of the 1st day of March, 1939, to the Corporate Trustee and W.J. KIEFERDORF, as Trustees, to secure payment of the principal of and the interest on an
