WHEREAS, heretofore Greenleaf Lumber Company, a Washington corporation, entered into a certain agreement dated June 11, 1925, with Western Spar Company, an Oregon corporation, for the use by the latter corporation of the logging railroad and booming facilities of said Greenleaf Lumber Company in Skamania County, Washington, and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, L. B. Menefee Lumber Company, has succeeded to all of the right, title and interest of said Greenleaf Lumber Company in and to the said logging railroad in Skamania County, Washington, and in and to the benefits accruing to said Greenleaf Lumber Company under said agreement, including the rental payments to be paid by the Western Spar Company, or its successors in interest, such rights of the Greenleaf Lumber Company being appurtenant to the said logging railroad and the lands heretofore owned by said Greenleaf Lumber Company in Skamania County, Washington;
