THIS SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE, made on the ninth day of December, 1941, by and between WEST COAST TELEPHONE COMPANY, a corporation duly created, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal place of business in Everett, Washington, (hereinafter sometimes called the "Company") and BANK OF AMERICA NATIONAL THUST AND SAVINGS ASSOCIATION, a National Banking Association, duly organized under an Act known as the "National Bank Act," of the United States of America, and having its principal place of business at San Francisco, California (hereinafter sometimes called the "Corporate Trustee"), and WILLIAM C. KOENIC of San Francisco, California (hereinafter sometimes called the "Individual Trustee"), as Trustees, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Company has proposed, in writing, certain changes and modifications of that certain Indenture dated as of March 1, 1939, and executed and delivered by the Company to the Corporate Trustee and W. J. Kieferdorf, the predecessor Individual Trustee, to secure the payment of the principal of and the interest on an authorized issue of bonds of the Company of an aggregate principal amount of not exceeding Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) at any one time outstanding, which Indenture has been recorded in the State of Washington as follows:

WHEREAS, on the ninth day of December, 1941, one hundred per cent (100%) of the bond-holders of the Company representing in the aggregate \$4,000,000 principal amount of the Company's First Mortgage Bonds, 3½% Series due 1971, being all of the First Mortgage Bonds of the Company then outstanding, delivered to the Corporate Trustee their consents to said changes and modifications of the Indenture and at the same time all of the bondholders deposited with the Corporate Trustee proof of the execution of such consents as provided by Section 2 of Article XI of the Indenture, and both said consents and said proofs of execution of said consents are now on file with the Corporate Trustee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Article XI of the Indenture, such changes and modifications of the Indenture are required to be set forth in a Supplemental Indenture between the Company and the Trustees:
