The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 twp. 2 N. R. 6 E. W.
