Know all men by these presents, That, I, James B. Nevin the owner and holder of that certain mortgage bearing date the 2nd day of May, 1932, executed by Grace Mackey and John J. Mackey to secure payment of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars and interest, and recorded in Volume T, at page 189 of the mortgage records of Skamania County, State of Washington, in consideration of the advantages which will or may accrue by virtue of the construction of an electric transmission line pursuant to the perpetual easement mentioned below and \$1.00 in paid in hand hereby consents and agrees that the lien of said mortgage shall be subordinate and subject to that certain perpetual easement, over, upon, across and under the following described land in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

That portion of the NW tof the NW tof Section 10, the SW tof the SW tof Section 3, and the South 200 feet of that part of the SEt of the SWt of Section 3 lying westerly of the center line of Secondary State Highway No. 8B, all in Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington; which lies within a strip of land 100 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 50 feet distant on either side of and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line as now located and staked on the ground, over, across, and upon the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 593+07.9, a point on the east line of Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, W. Whe undersigned hereby waives the priority of said mortgage in favor of said perpetual easement to the same extent as if an easement deed has been executed, delivered and recorded prior to the mortgage hereinabove described, and agrees that in the event of foreclosure of said mortgage the premises shall be sold subject to the aforementioned easement.
