Know all men by these presents, That Robt. C. Prindle, the owner and holder of that certain mortgage bearing date the second day of May, 1936, executed by A. T. Sunderlin and Eva Marie Sunderlin, husband and wife, to secure payment of the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and interest, and recorded in Volume "T", at page 591 of the Mortgage records of Skamania County, State of Washington, in consideration of the advantages which will or may accrue by firtue of the construction of the advantages which will or may accrue by firtue of Dollars (\$1.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby consents and grees that the lien of Said mortgage shall be subordinate and subject to that certain perpetual easement over, upon, across, and under the following described land in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

That portion of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NW^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of the $NW^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 6 East, W.
