Assignment of $\frac{1}{2}$ interest in 4 right of way easements-The Skamania Co-Operative Telephone Association-To-The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company.

In the consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar and other valuable consideration paid by the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, to the SKAMANIA CO-OPERATIVE TELEPHONE ASSOCIATION, a corporation, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said THE SKAMANIA CO-OPERATIVE TELEPHONE ASSOCIATION does hereby assign, transfer and set over unto said The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors and assigns, forever, an undivided one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) interest in and to the following described rights of way, situate, lying and being in the county of Skamania, State of Washington, acquired by said the Skamania Co-Operative Telephone Association from the following named parties, by the following described conveyances, reference to which is hereby made for a more particular description of said rights of way:

FIRST: Nellie E. Ash-Right of way dated June 11, 1923, acquired by final decree of condemnation No. 1452, in the Superior Court of the State of Washington, in and for the County of Skamania, Recorded in Book "S" of Deeds at page 891 Records of Skamania County, by which a right of way is granted over the property of Nellie E. Ash, situate in section Eleven (11), Township Two (2) North, Range Seven (7) East, W.M. as more particularly described in said final decree of Condemnation No. 1452.

SECOND: Interlaken Resort Company-Right of way dated July 5, 1922, granting the right to erect and maintain poles with the necessary wires and fixtures thereon across that certain property belonging to Interlaken Resort Company, situate in the southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eleven (11), Township Two (2) North, range seven (7) East, W.M., recorded in book 5 of deeds on page 629, records of Skamania County.

THIRD: I. C. Lott-Right of way dated June 30, 1922, granting the right to erect and maintain poles with the necessary wires and fixtures thereon across that certain property belonging to I. C. Lott, situate in the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section one (1), Township Two (2) North, Range seven (7) East W.M. recorded in book 5 of deeds on page 630 records of Skamania County.

FOURTH: Harry Hazard-Right of way dated June 30, 1922, granting the right to erect and maintain poles with the necessary wires and fixtures thereon across that certain property belonging to Harry Hazard, situate in the east half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section Two (2), township (2) North, range seven (7) East, W.M., recorded in book 5 of deeds on 628 Records of Skamania County.
