Powers, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed, do by these presents remise, release, convey and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, all their right, title and interest in and to the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Chenoweth D.L.C. on the North line of State Highway No. 8, 1574 feet west of the section line between sections 21 and 22 in Township Two North range 7 east of the Willamett Meridian, and running thence north to the shore of Bass Lake; Thence westerly along the shore of Bass Lake to a point 100 feet west of the last described line; thence south to State Highway No 8; thence easterly along State Highway No 8 to the place of beginning and containing three acres more or less. The right to cross said land to lay and maintain water mains to pipe water from Bass Lake is reserved.
