By section 596, Washington statutes, it is provided that as to property to which title has been acquired by foreclosure subject to the period of redemption "If the purchaser or redemptioner shall pay any taxes or assessments--- he must file a statement thereof with the Auditor of the County where said property is situated before the property shall have been redeemed from him. Otherwise the property
