IN THE MATTER OF STATE ROAD No 8 Wind River Bridge approaches.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That Anna F. Monaghan, A Widow of the County of Skamania, in the State of Washington, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of Seventy Five Dollars in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant bargain sell and convey unto the State of Washington the Following described parcel of land situated in Skamania County, Washington to-wit: A strip of land 70 feet wide, being 35 feet on each side of the center line of said road as surveyed over and across lot 6 sec, 27 Twp 3 N, R. 8 East W.M. Extending from the north line of said lot 6 to the northerly right of way line of State road No. 8. except as follows: from survey station 7+50 to the northerly right of way line of said State road No. 8 it shall be 75 feet wide on the westerly side of said center line, from station 8+17.9, to station 6+00 on the westerly line of Wind River it shall be of varying widths on the easterly side of said center line, the course of said strip boundary line being S 41°46' East, and from station 6+00 to the northerly right of way line of said State road No 8 it shall be of varying widths on the easterly side of center line its boundary line being the westerly line of Wind River. Said Survey approved May 22, 1928 and of record in State Highway Engineers office at Olympia, State of Washington, as shown on attached maps in red outline and made a part hereof.
