Jones party of the second part: Witnesseth, That whereas at a public sale of real estate held on the 21st day of January A.D. 1928 pursuant to a real estate tax judgement entered in the Superior Court in the County of Skamania on the 3rd day of January A.D. 1928 in proceedings to foreclose tax liens upon real estate and an order of sale duly issued by said court, D.F.
