DEED From

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that HOME VALLEY IRRIGATION AND POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Washington, in consideration of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to it paid by C. S. HAIL, whose wife's name is Emma Hail, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the fulfillment of a contract of sale made by the grantor to the grantee, bearing date March 16, 1926, has bargained and sold and does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. S. HAIL and unto his heirs and assigns forever, all of the following described real property lying and being situate in Skamania County, Washington, to wit:

The Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) North, Range Seven and one-half (7½) East, Willamette Meridian; also all that portion of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) North of Range Seven and one-half (7½) East, Willamette Meridian lying West of Panther Creek.

No water rights are included.

The grantee assumes whatever liens there may now exist against said premises.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said above described and granted premises unto the said C. S. HAIL and unto his heirs and assigns forever.
