#15461-Deed-P.S.C. Wills to Bertha McKeighan

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That P.S.C. Wills, a single man, party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable considerations, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Bertha McKeighan party of the second part the following described real and personal property in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

The east half of the southeast quarter of sec 34 tp 3<sup>N</sup> R 7 E.W.M., and also the west half of the southwest quarter of sec 35 tp 3 N R 7 E.W.M., excepting from the last described tract a parcel of land containing 10 acres known as the Lebong land, and described in deed from E.P. Ash and Nellie Ash to Charles Lebong recorded at page 350 book "L" of deeds, records of Skamania County, Wash. and also excepting a 30 foot roadway from said 10 acre tract across said west half of the southwest quarter of said sec 35.

Lots 2 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec 2, tp 2 N R 7 E.W.M., containing 52 acres more or less.

Also a water right filed by Maiden and King August 7, 1907, and recorded Book "E" of miscellaneous records, page 252 and Also the pipe and pipe line extending from the spring and Lebong creek in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of sec 34 in tp 3 N R 7 E.W.M. in a southerly direction to the intake spring belonging to the Stevenson Water Company known as the Leonard Spring, being a pipe line of approximately 1200 feet in length.

Also pipe, piping, pipe line, and easement for pipe line extending from spring situated in the northeast quarter of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec 34 tp 3 N R 7 E.W.M., thence easterly over sections 34 and 35 to bridge across Rock Creek on the Ryan-Allen County Road; thence following the Ryan-Allen County road to intersection of Rock Creek road with McKinley Street in Roselawn addition to the town of Stevenson.

Also easement for pipe line <sup>across</sup> the property belonging to Roy Shultz and known as the Lebong tract in section 35 tp 3 N R 7 E.W.M.

Also easement for pipe line across, or to be secured across property belonging to Ryan-Allen mill company in said section 35.
