THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

TO ALL TO WHOME THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, F.A. Hyde being the owner of a tract of land situated and included within the limits of a public Forest Reservation, known and officially designated as the Sierra Forest Reserve, California, has, under the provisions of the Act approved June 4,1897 entitled, and act making appropriations for sundry civil expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, eighteen hundred and ninety eight, and for other purposes, "reconveyed and relinquished the said Tract to the United States and has, under the provisions of this act, selected in lieu thereof the following described tract of vacant Public Land now open to settlement, to-wit:

The east half of the northeast quarter and the east half of the southeast quarter of section thirty-five in Township eight north of Range six east of the Willamett Meridian Washington, containing one hundred sixty acres, according the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Burveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents LDOES GIVE AND GRANT unto the said F.A. Hyde and to his heirs, the land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appertenances, of what soever nature thereun to belonging, unto the said F.A. Hyde, and to his heirs and assigns foever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the UNITED STATES.
