(ORDER SETTING ASIDE PROPERTY IN LIEU OF HOMESTEAD ETC)

In the above entitled estate, John F. Wood, the surviving husband of said deceased, and administrator of the estate of said deceased, having filed his inventory of the property of said estate and appraisement thereof fixing the value of all such estate at \$1450, And such surviving husband and administrator having on the 18th day of September 1928 filed herein his petition to have all of said estate set apart to said surviving husband in lieu of homestead, and the court having set the time for hearing of said petition for October 1st at 1-30 p m, and directing notices to be posted therefor; And at the time and place fixed in said order and notice for hearing this 1st day of October 1928, the said petition coming on regularly to be heard, and evidence adduced by the petitioner and the matter submitted to the court for decision;

The court now finds that such \$1450, was the fair value of all the property of said estate, and due and legal notice of the hearing on said petition was given as required by said order and as provided by law, and that no objections have been thereto, and that said petitioner is the surviving husband of said deceased, and that no homestead has been selected or claimed; and that all costs of last sickness, funeral expenses and costs of administration have been paid, and, Now therefore it is hereby ordered and adjudged, that said appraisement be and the same is confirmed, and said petition granted, and all of the property of said estate is hereby set apart and aside to said John F. Wood, the surviving husband of said deceased, as his sole and separate property free of all claims, which said property is described as follows:
