Albert E. Le Roy by exec to Lynn A. Le Roy et al

Albert E. LeRoy, Deceased. Final Decree of Distribution.

The within cause coming duly on for hearing on the final report and petition
for distribution filed by ^{the} executrix, Lynn A. LeRoy, or the last will and estate of
Albert E. LeRoy, deceased; and said executrix being present in Court and represented
by her attorney of record, Frank Groundwater, the Court finds and decrees, after hear-
ing the evidence as follows:

FIRST: That on August 17th, 1928, Albert E. LeRoy died testate in Grays Harbor
County, Washington; that at the time of his death he was a resident of said county;
that said Lynn A. LeRoy was duly and legally appointed executrix of the estate of
said deceased; that she qualified and duly acted as such executrix during the probate
proceedings herein; that the will of said deceased was duly admitted to probate in
this court.

SECOND: That due and legal notice of the time and place of the hearing of said
final report and petition for distribution, was posted, published and given as by law
and the order of the Court required.

THIRD: The Court finds that due and legal notice to creditors of said deceased and
his estate, was published in the ¹Elma Chronicle, a newspaper published at Elma in said
county, as by law and the order of the Court requires and directed; that more than six
months elapsed since the date of the first publication of said notice and the filing
of said final report and petition for distribution; that proof of publication of said
notice has been duly filed in this cause.
