Lyle W. Ternahan et ux to Pioneer State Bank

REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE

THIS INDENTURE, made the 23rd day of March, 1944, by and between Lyle W. Ternahan and  
Rosalyn B. Ternahan, husband and wife of Skamania County, Washington, parties of the first  
part, and PIONEER STATE BANK, a Washington Corporation, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the  
sum of Ten Thousand and No/100 DOLLARS, to them in hand paid, by the said party of the  
second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold,  
and by these present do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second  
part, its successors or assigns, the following described premises, situate, lying and be-  
ing in Skamania County, State of Washington, and more particularly described as follows,  
to-wit:

The East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the  
Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 20, Township Three (3) North, Range Ten (10)  
East, Willamette Meridian; and Lots Three (3) and Four (4) of Section Twenty-nine  
(29), Township Three (3) North, Range Ten (10) East, Willamette Meridian, except  
right of way S. P. & S. Railway Company, easement granted to Northwestern Electric  
Company and State and County Roads and easement over Fifteen (15) feet along E.  
line Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20),  
above referred to. Except that portion of Lots Three (3) and Four (4) north of  
State Road No. Eight (8), now known as Evergreen Highway, as the same crosses said  
Lots Three (3) and Four (4).

The Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ )  
of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20), Township Three (3) North,  
Range Ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington,  
SAVE AND EXCEPT therefrom all rights-of-ways or easements for roads or roadways  
as heretofore established, and now traveled over and across said premises and al-  
so excepting easements or right-of-ways heretofore granted for electric transmis-  
sion lines and telephone lines.
