IN THE MATTER OF STATE ROAD NO. 8 STEVENSON TO WIND RIVER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. F. SWEENEY and MARRY E. SWEENEY, his wife, of the County of Skamania, in the State of Washington, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of Six Hundred and Seventy-five Dollars, in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the STATE OF WASHINGTON the following described parcel of land situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 100 feet wide, being 50 feet on each side of the center line of said road as surveyed over and across the NW1 of the NE1, Lot 6 and that part of Lot 5 lying North of the County Road of Section 31 Twp. 3 North Range 8 East W.M. Except as follows:

From the West line of said Lot 5 to survey station 153/00 it shall be 75 feet wide, from station 153/00 to station 154/00 it shall be 90 feet wide, from station 156/50 to station 163/50 it shall be 70 feet wide; from station 163/50 to station 165/00 it shall be 90 feet wide; from station 165/00 to station 172/99 it shall be 60 feet wide; from station 178/50 to station 179/50 it shall be 60 feet wide and from station 185/00 to station 186/00 it shall be 90 feet wide; all on the Northerly side of said center line.

from station 154/00 to station 157/50 it shall be 75 feet wide; from station 163/10 to station 165/95 it shall be 160 feet wide; from station 165/95 to station 169/50 it shall be 70 feet wide; from station 169/50 to station 173/50 it shall be 150 feet wide and from station 182/00 to station 183/50 it shall be 150 feet wide, all on the southerly side of said center line.
