WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and fifty (\$550.00) Dollars, to E. F. them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby F.F. acknowledged do hereby Grant Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Klickitat F. F. and State of Washington, described as follows, to-wit:

The East half of the south-west quarter, and lots numbered three and four of section thirty, in township six, north of Range ten, east of Willamette Meridian in Washington, containing one hundred and fifty six and ninety-one hundredths acres and all of lots Three (3) and four (4) and the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the South west quarter ( $\frac{SW}{4}$ ) of section thirty one ( Sec. 31) township six (T.6) North of range Ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian
