Know All Men By These Presents That the Cascadia Mining and Development Company, a corporation incorporated organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, in consideration of Sixty Thousand Dollars to it paid by the Polar Star Mining Company a corporation has bargained and sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said Polar Star Mining Company, its successors and assigns all the following described real and mining property situate and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington: to-wit

That certain mining claims or premises known as the Black Falls No. 1, Polar Star No. 2, Polar Star No 3, Polar Star Junior, No 3, Polar Star Junior No 1, Phil Sheridan No 2, Black Hawk, Polar Star No 1., Black Falls No 2, Phil Sheridan No 1, and Polar Star Junior No 2, lode mining claims designated by the surveyor general as survey No 689A, embracing a portion of section 13 in township 10 north range 5 east and section 7 and 18 in township 10 north of range 6 east W.M. in the St Helens, unorganized, mining district in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and bounded as follows: Beginning for the description of the Black Falls No 1, lode claim at corner No 1 from which the quarter corner to sections 7 and 18 in township 10 north of range 6 east bears north 47 deg. 15 min. 42 sec E 3006.11 feet distant, and running thence north 64 deg 45 min E 1430.8 feet to corner No 2, thence north 25 deg 15 min W 600 feet to corner No 3, thence S 64 deg 45 min W 1430.8 feet to corner No 4, and thence S 25 deg 15 min E 600 feet to corner No 1, the place of beginning.
