Beginning for the description of the Minnie Lee No 2 Millsite claim lot No 697 B at corner No 1, identical with corner No 2 of said Minnie Lee No 1 millsite claim, from which said U S location monument No 5, bears north 49 degrees 46 minutes 57 seconds East 1793.74 feet distant, and running thence north 50 degrees 56 minutes West 732.08 feet to corner No 2, thence south 39 degrees 4 minutes west 290.4 feet to corner no 3, thence south 50 degrees 56 minutes East 767.92 feet to corner No 4, identical with corner No 3 of said Minnie Lee No 1 millsite claim, and thence north 32 degrees 2 minutes East 292.61 feet to corner No 1 the place of beginning; said lot No 697 B containing 10 acres, which together with the area embraced in said lot No 697 A aggregates 113.305 acres.
