

DEED RECORD W
SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

Parcel 8:

The east half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-seven (27), Township two (2) north, range five (5) east of Willamette Meridian.

Parcel 9:

All that part of the northwest quarter of Section numbered twenty six (26) in Township numbered two (2) north range numbered five (5) east of Willamette Meridian, lying west of the center of the Washougal River, containing twenty (20) acres, more or less.

Parcel 10:

The northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section fourteen (14), the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the West half of the southeast quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section fifteen (15), in Township two (2) north of Range five (5) east, of Willamette Meridian, containing three hundred and twenty (320) acres. Excepting out of this deed, and always reserving unto Hiram W. Sibley and wife, their heirs and assigns, a right of way over and across said lands for logging purposes, and free ingress, egress and regress through said lands in and along the bounds or sides of the Washougal River for driving logs.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all their estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said J. R. BOWLES, his heirs and assigns forever. And CHARLES D. BOWLES and ALMEDA T. BOWLES, his wife, grantors above named do covenant to and with J. R. BOWLES, the above named grantee, his heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances., and that they will and their heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
