Easement Deed

NORTHWESTERN ELECTRIC COMPANY TO PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

THE GRANTOR Northwestern Electric Company, a Washington Corporation of Skamania County, Washington for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid conveys and warrants to Pacific Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, an easement or right-of-way for and electric transmission and distributing line of one or more wires and all necessary or desirable appurtenances (including telephone and telegraph wires, towers, poles, props, guys and other supports and including the right to place, all said lines in underground conduits) at or near the location and along the general course now located and staked out and constructed by the Grantee over, across and upon the following described premises, located in Skamania County, Washington to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section fourteen (14) Township Three (3) North Range Ten (10) East Willamette Meridian.

Together with the right of ingress^{and egress} over the adjacent lands of the Grantor for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, stringing new wires, on, maintaining and removing said lines and appurtenances, and exercising other rights hereby granted.

All rights hereunder shall cease when said lines have been abandoned.
