THIS INDENTURE, Made this fifteenth day of June A.D. 1945 between BANKERS TRUST COM-PANY, a corporation under the laws of the state of New York, Trustee, hereinafter called "The Trustee", party of the first part, and the NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, party of the second part,
