Irons, husband and wife, parties of the second part, do hereby remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

All land lying between the center line of the Washougal River and that tract of land conveyed by the party of the first part to Angus P. Hanley by deed dated September 13, 1921, and recorded at page 362, Book "S" of Deeds, records of Skamania County, Washington. It being the intent of the grantor hereby to extend the boundary of the above mentioned tract of land so that its southerly boundary shall be the center line of the Washougal River.
