JOHN F. SWEENEY, et ux to STATE OF WASHINGTON
Borrow Permit

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That John F. Sweeney and Marey E. Sweeney, his wife, of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five no/100 Dollars, in hand paid to them the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant unto the State of Washington, the right to take materials, consisting of rock, gravel, sand and earth from any portion of the hereinafter described tract of land for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and repairing highways, at any and all times, from date hereof until 5 years from date herein together with the right to operate necessary equipment thereon and the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of removing said materials therefrom, to the right of way of State Road No. 8 said tract of land being situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington and described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31 Township 3 North Range 8 East, W. M., containing 0.36 acres, more or less, lying northwesterly of and contiguous to the existing right of way for State Road No. 8 and being between highway station 169+00, and highway station 170+05. As a further consideration the State of Washington is to compensate the grantors herein for any damages that may be sustained by the adjoining property caused by the operations of the borrow pit.
