16865-STATUTORY QUIT CLAIM DEED

THE GRANTOR, Mrs Nellie Fraser, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, conveys and quit claims to Ben F. Hofer all interest in the following described real estate, to-wit:

That certain mining claim designated and known as Jim Quartz claim location No. 2, as shown by the original notice thereof properly posted upon said claim and filed in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, on August 1, 1930, at 11:30^{0'clock} in the forenoon on said day, and recorded in book F of Mining locations at page 512. Said Claim as located being 1500 linear feet horizontal measurement on the strike of lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations as allowed by law, together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of said vein at the surface grounds within the lines of said claim.
