### STATUTORY QUIT CLAIM DEED

THE GRANTORS, Ben, F. Hofer and Eva Jane Hofer, for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, convey and quitclaim to CAMP CREEK METALS MINING COMPANY, Inc., all interest in the following described real estate, all situated and located in the Nigger head Mining District in Skamania County in the State of Washington, to wit:

That certain mining claim designated and known as Iolene Quartz Mining Claim, as shown by the original notice thereof properly posted <sup>upon said claim</sup> and filed in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, on July 13, 1929, at 1:10 P.M. on said day, and recorded in book F of mining locations at page 415, said claim as located being 1500 linear feet horizontal measurement on the strike of lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof with all dips, spurs, angles and variations as allowed by law, together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of said vein at the surface ground within the lines of said claim.
