## SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

Also that certain mining claim designated and known as The Oh Bill Fraction<sup>Quartz</sup> Mining claim, as shown by the original notice<sup>thereof</sup> posted upon said claim and filed in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, on August 1, 1930 at 11:30 A.M. on said day, and recorded in book F. of Mining Locations at page 511, said claim as located being 1500 linear feet horizontal measurement on the strike of lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips, spurs, angles and variations as allowed by law, together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of said claim at the surface ground within the lines of said claim.
