This Deeds, made the twenty-fifth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, by the Northern Pacific Railway Company, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, party of the first part, and the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Washington, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of ten dollars (\$10) and other valuable considerations to it in hand paid, does GRANT, BARGAIN, and CONVEY unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described tracts of dand situate in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, to-wit:

Lots three (3), twenty (20), twenty-one (21), twenty-two (22), twenty-three (23) and twenty-four (24) in Section eighteen (18), Lots one (1) and nine (9) in Section twenty-eight (28), all in township ten (10) North of Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Principal Meridian, containing one hundred sixty-two and nineteen hundredths (162.19) acres, more pr less, according to the United States Government Survey; excepting and reserving unto the party of the first part, its successors and assigns, forever, all minerals of any nature whatsoever, including coal, iron, natural gas and oil, upon or in said land, together with the use of such of the surface as may be necessary for exploring for and mining or otherwise extracting and carrying away the same;

but the party of the first part, its successors and assigns, shall pay to the party of the second part, or to its successors or assigns, the market value at the time mining operations are commenced of such portion of the surface as may be used for such operations, or injured thereby, including any improvements thereon; the lands hereby granted being subject to an easement in the public for any public roads heretofore laid out or established, and now existing over and across any part of the premises; and also subject, as reserved in the patent from the United States, to a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.
