Item Four: I hereby direct that my executrix is authorized and empowered to administer my estate under the provisions of this will without the aid or intervention of any probate court or other court having probate jurisdiction.

Item Five: I hereby appoint my beloved wife, Almeda T. Bowles, as executrix of this my last will and testament and direct that no bonds be required of her as such executrix.

To the Hon. Judge of the Probate Department of the above entitled court:

The Petition of Almeda T. Bowles respectfully represents:

1. That Charles D. Bowles died at the City of Portland, Oregon on the 10th day of January, 1924, being at the time of his death a resident of the City of Seattle, King County Washington, and leaving estate in said County and subject to administration therein, consisting of the sum of approximately \$49,000 cash in banks, bonds of the approximate value of \$1,000,000, stocks in corporations of the approximate value of \$200,000, treasury notes and certificates of the approximate value of \$88,000, accounts and bills receivable of the approximate value of \$50,000, and one piece of real property located in King County, Washington, more particularly described as follows:

Lots 6 and 7 and the East half of the Southwest quarter of Section 6, township 24, north, range 7 East W. M.

of the approximate value of \$2,000.

All of the property of the estate of said decedent and as above mentioned was the community property of the said decedent and his surviving wife, your petitioner, Almeda T. Bowles.

2. That said decedent died testate, having executed his last will and testament on the 9th day of January, 1924, but which is incorrectly dated as of December 29, 1923, in the presence of C. G. Sabin and H. C. Bean, two competent witnesses, that said witnesses to said will subscribed their names as witnesses thereto on said 9th day of January, 1924 at the request of said decedent and in his presence and in the presence of each other, and said decedent executed said will in the presence of said witnesses on said 9th day of January, 1924, to whom he declared the same to be his last will and testament, and which said will your petitioner alleges to be the last will and testament of said decedent, and she presents to and files with this court the same for probate as such last will and testament.
