In Yakima County, State of Washington:

C-71 Item: That portion of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 6, Township 12 North, Range 20 East of Willamette Meridian, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point near the southwest corner of said section where the east line of the county road intersects the north line of the cross road; thence north along said east line 50 feet; thence east 100 feet; thence south 50 feet to north line of cross road; thence west along said north line of road 100 feet to the point of beginning.

C-72--Spruce Street Substation

C-74--Toppenish Substation

In Yakima County, State of Washington:

C-74 Item: Lots 25, 26, and 27, Block 5, McQuesten's Toppenish Townsite, a platted and recorded townsite.

C-75--Union Gap Substation and Switching Station

In Yakima County, State of Washington:

C-75 Item: All those portions of Lots2 and of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 6, Township 12 North, Range 19 East of Willamette Meridian, lying southwesterly of the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company's right of way.

C-76--Wapato Substation

In Yakima County, State of Washington:

C-76 Item: A parcel of land in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 10, Township 11 North, Range 19 East of Willamette Meridian, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the east line of said section intersects the north-easterly line of a county road, which line is parallel with and 40 feet north-easterly from the northeasterly line of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's station grounds at Wapato; thence northwesterly along said parallel line 93.75 feet; thence northeasterly, at right angle to said parallel line, 100.1 feet, more or less, to intersection with the east line of said section; thence south 137.2 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
